And the city has spoken.

Over the past four months, *Cult MTL* readers and other citizens who are invested in civic pride voted for their favourite Montreal things in the annual Best of MTL poll.

When voting began back in February, we didn't know where the pandemic was going, how bad it would get and when precisely life might return to normal. While some question marks remain, the summer is pretty much upon us and with it the annual blooming of the city has begun. This year, that bloom is extra sweet and colourful, accompanied by the end of the curfew and the gradual reopening of everything that has been closed, and the resumption of gatherings and activities that were rendered dangerous by the pandemic, before the vaccine rollout finally flattened that curve. We're nearly there, but we're more than cautiously optimistic — we're thrilled that the city is on the comeback trail, and that the Best of MTL can be part of heralding a return to normality.

This hasn't been an easy past year, and some have had it worse than others — something that's important to remember as we interact with people again, and see familiar faces for the first time in months.

Here at *Cult MTL*, we're grateful for our extended family, for our readers, and for the voters in this poll who took the time during the dark winter and spring of 2021 to think about everything they love in this city, and can't wait to get back to. As always, and maybe more than ever, we felt it was imperative to salute the artists, promoters, organizers, reporters, restaurateurs and retailers who have kept Montreal's heart beating, even in partial stasis.

As always, the Best of MTL poll is open and democratic, with no editorial influence or interference. We are always glad to see so many people make an event of voting via social media campaigns, and while we can't resist sharing third-party get-out-the-vote tweets, we otherwise remain neutral during the polling period.

Ballot-stuffing is automatically weeded out by our survey software. This year there were loads of votes for musician, comedian and social media personality Eve Parker Finley, columnist and social media personality Murphy Cooper, comedian/radio host Julian Bernatchez and local label On a Roll Records (and friends) in way too many categories. Joke votes were relatively minimal but there was at least one person who took the time to vote for "healthcare workers" in nearly every category and others who chastised us for legacy categories like Best Place to Have Public Sex as irresponsible during a pandemic. Conversely, a handful of conspiracy theorists and anti-lockdown/anti-mask types shared comments like "Montreal is a dump," «this is a socialist gulag," «not allowed to have fun in this prison» and «they outlawed art» across dozens of categories.

*Cult MTL* has been running the Best of MTL readers poll for nine years, but it bears mentioning that the survey follows in the decades-old tradition established by the city's defunct but fondly remembered alt-weekly newspaper the *Mirror*. Respect.

Along with the expanded Top 10 lists in every category (coming to cultmtl.com in the coming days), our website will feature a number of Best of MTL articles through the month of June and beyond.

We thank everyone who voted and promoted the poll. Participation continues to grow every year, making the 2021 results more representative of the city than ever.

(Anglos, if you're wondering why you don't recognize some names in these lists, it's because the other 70 per cent of the population is now voting in a bilingual poll. Francos, désolé, les résultats sont unilingue.)

To all the winners: congratulations.

# People & Places

Musician and social media maven Eve Parker Finley is new to the Best of MTL — to a whopping five categories across three sections — so welcome to the ranks. In this section, Finley arrives at #2 in Best-Dressed Montrealer, between music superstar Celine Dion and style superstar Cary Tauben. Last year we described compiling the results in this category as “the bitter in the bittersweetness of Best of MTL 2020,” but as the pandemic has dragged, forcing the closure of all of these places save for a couple of half-hearted months last summer (with a winter/spring curfew on top of everything), the flavour of nightlife in this city is practically foul. But with the vaccine rollout and a Quebec reopening plan that appears to be coming together, it's only a matter of time before we're partying together again. Drinking at concerts will be possible as early as June 7, bars can open their terrasses on June 11 and outdoor festival shows with crowds of 2,500 will be possible by June 25 — yes there will be certain mask and distancing requirements over the summer, but come fall, even small clubs may operate normally again, mask-free. Here's hoping.

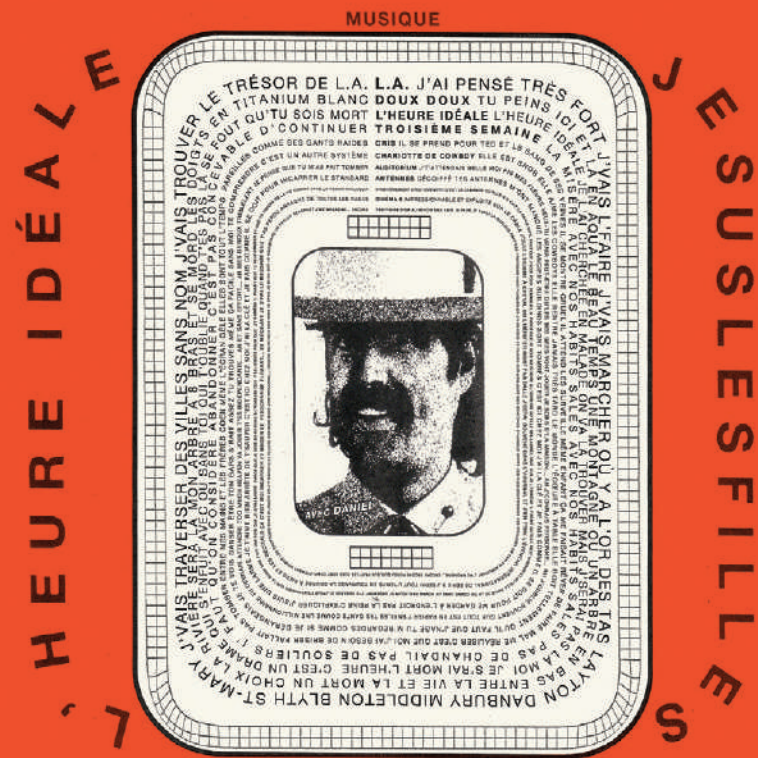

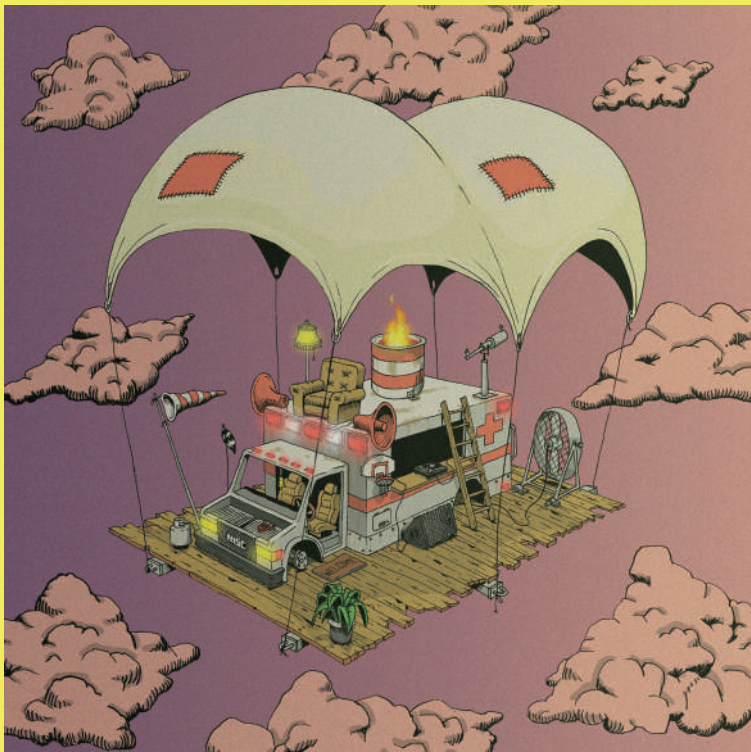

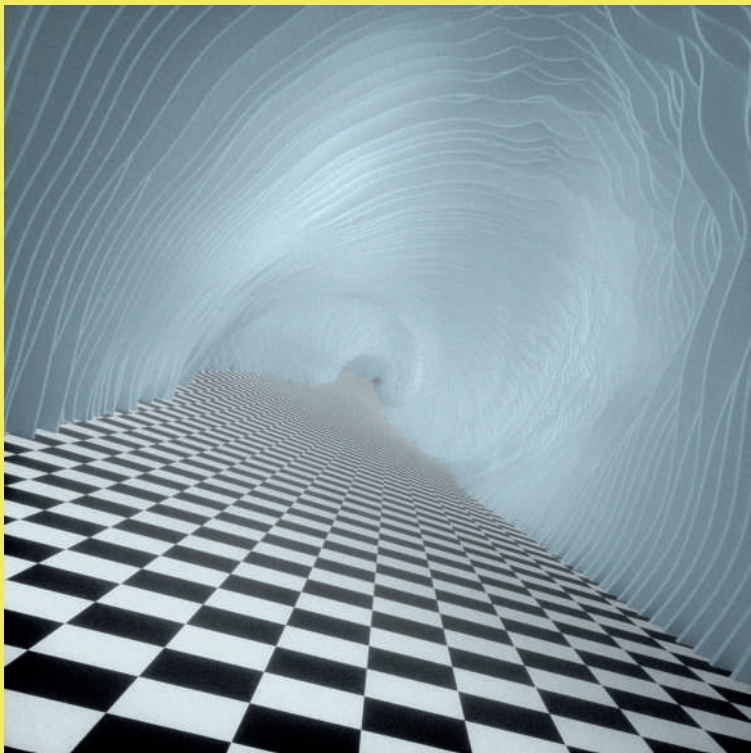

# Film & Arts

I want to begin this year's response to our Best of MTL list with a statement: If you're a restaurant owner and your business survived this far, you should be immensely proud.

Every measure of excellence in hospitality has been thrown for a loop this year. Guides like Canada's 100 best, Les Prix Lauriers and, most notably, the Michelin Guide all adapted their models in an attempt to consider the circumstances that COVID-19 presented to the industry. For many who follow the goings-on of the food world, the very nature of a system that compares and ranks restaurants was called into question. Who do these lists serve? Who is on them, who is not, and why? Prior to the pandemic, the restaurant biz was reaching its loftiest heights in the contemporary era. We had long surpassed the groupie-esque admiration of "rockstar" chefs, graduating to a near-sycophantic worship of "genius-level" restaurateurs.

These guides, in conjunction with food media, are responsible for reframing the good, noble craft of cooking and turning it into a narcissistic, self-congratulating

feedback loop where those with the deepest pockets and most rarefied ingredients compete for a level of supremacy that most people will never be exposed to. When the walls came tumbling down, much of the restaurant world was exposed for what it truly is: a means to an end. Suddenly, without all the pomp and grandeur of lavish dining rooms, custom French ranges and hand-thrown ceramic plates, the playing field changed. The dry-aged duck magret sauced with 1999 Puffeney Vin Jaune and your favourite Indian joint's Palak Paneer become a lot easier to compare when placed side by side on your coffee table.

For me, this circumstance has exposed a fundamental truth about food and restaurants: most of it is theatre, and there's nothing wrong with that. To eat a meal in a magnificent dining room, to taste a foraged ramp served moments after being plucked from the earth, to savour a wine coddled and incubated for years before being poured exactly at the very height of its potential is truly wonderful. The theatre of it all makes for a great, even heightened dining experience, but it has very little to do with what makes food good.

At Cult MTL, our list presents far less influence from the world of food. It is judged by people with everyday experience who express only what is true for them — their

favourite spots, the places that serve the dishes they love to eat. This year, there is only one resto wrong: pitting restaurants against each other for a spot on a list. And while this remains a best-of list, I think of it that way in format only. If I can offer a suggestion to those reading this list, it would be to see it as a reflection of the places and dishes that connected with people, offered them comfort, satiated cravings and helped mark milestones and celebrations in a year where expressions of joy were fleeting and so hard to separate from everyday life.

As we emerge from the pandemic, with restaurant terraces newly open again and bars not far behind, I hope we reflect on all that the restaurant industry has suffered and all that it has given to us. I hope that we remember that greatness in food is not limited to the restaurants that top prestigious lists. Great restaurants — the best restaurants — achieve that status because they connect with people in a meaningful way.

One last thought. It's been a while since we've all been out to eat at a restaurant — go easy on the staff, please. Be patient, compassionate and forgiving — I can tell you from experience (on both sides) that these qualities are rewarded tenfold.



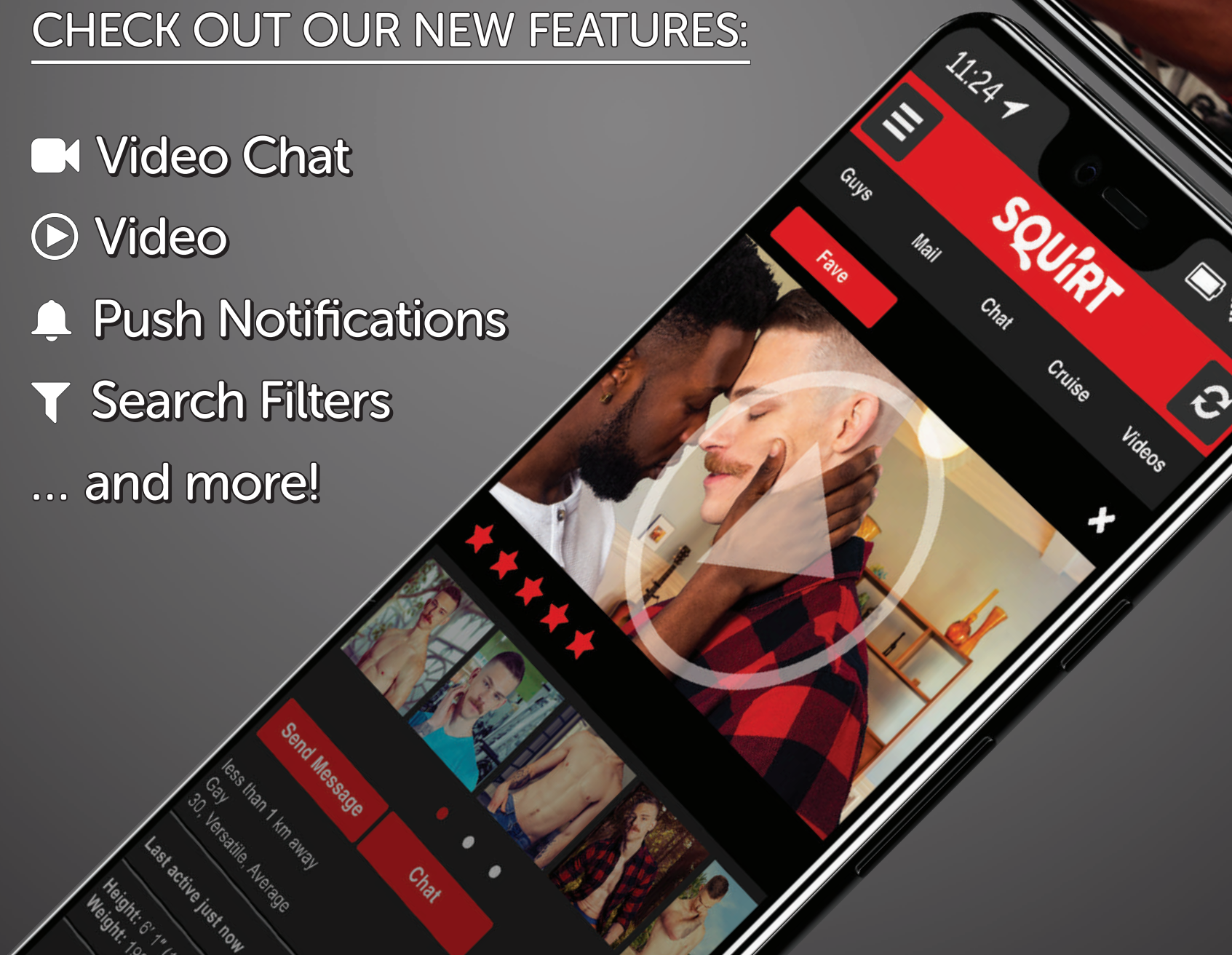
